2019-20-1

1. CBCS Workshops – Resolved that IQAC in collaboration with different dept to organise such workshops.

2019-20-2

1. Setting up of common computer laboratory: Resolved that to meet up the need for IFF, Food and Nutrition, Human Development, Bengali and Sanskrit departments, some computers will be arranged from computer science departments so that immediate necessity can be satisfied. Tenders will be floated for purchase of computers to construct a common computer laboratory for these departments.
2. Training for self defense course and Yoga: Resolved that department of Physical education be requested to promulgate the necessity of such courses among students through interactive session. Affiliating university WBSU be moved for approval of these courses and agencies be contacted for commencement of these programmes.
3. Resolved that the IQAC will extend all support in organisation of International Seminar on Values and Ethics by Dept. of Education and Philosophy in association with WBSU

2019-20-3

1. Internet connection: Resolved that quotations will be invited for setup of college – network with single Optical Fibre Raw data connection in order to circumvent the existing problem.
2. MOU: Resolved that necessary steps be taken for signing/renewal of MOU with nearby institutions.



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3. Skill development Courses: Resolved that department of journalism and mass communication and department of food and nutrition be asked to prepare themselves for the commencement of "Certificate course on Digital Photography – from Passion to Career" and certificate course on food processing respectively. Further resolved that necessary steps be taken for approval of the aforesaid courses from WBSU.
4. Outreach programmes: Resolved that the NSS wing will take initiative to organize programme on Health Checkup for children of Locality involving a nutritionist with active support from the college authority.
