The Principal began the meeting by welcoming the members of the IQAC. He thanked the members for joining in ONLINE mode in these troubled times. The convener was asked to give a brief summary of the developments which have taken place in the college since the last meeting

- The convenor informed the members that a large number of webinars had been organized by the different department s of the college in collaboration with IQAC since the last meeting.

 - (ii) Online Workshop on Research Methodology- Five Day FDP in collaboration with East Calcutta Girls' college.
- 4. Relief Work (i) In collaboration with East Calcutta Girls' College, APC College has taken part in a relief programme in the Amphan affected area in South 24 Parganas district. The funding was raised from the registration fees collected from the participants of a Faculty Development Programmeorganized collaboratively by East Calcutta Girls College and Acharya Prafula Chandra College during the pandemic period.
 - (iii) The employees of this college have raised a fund and donated to the Chief Minister's relief fund towards relief to Amphan affected people. The students, teachers and non-teaching staff of college have extended whole-hearted support towards giving relief to



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the people affected by the Amphan super cyclone. Relief materials were distributed to a section of affected people in Nazat village in Sandeshkhali, Sunderban.

Proposals / Discussion

- ONLINE TEACHING The coordinator informed the members that the faculty members had
 overcome their initial difficulties were making full use of the Google classroom available with
 the Gsuite for Education subscribed by the college. Some teachers were also uploading
 lectures on Youtube. Departmental whatsapp groups had been created for sharing of
 information, class materials etc amongst students.
- 2. RUSA Principal informed the members that the College had received second installment of Rs. 50 lakhs. However Dr. Ghosal , who is also the Nodal Officer RUSA informed that with regard to purchase of ICT items the college was unable to place orders as most of the vendors selected through e-tender has expressed their inability to comply due to severe shortage of ICT equipments in lockdown environment. It was felt that a second call be floated after normalization of COVID situation.
- 3. Dr. Chaitali Bhattacharya mentioned that although a webinar on "Psychological Wellbeing During The Pandemic" had been organized by the Human Development dept. the college needs to hold a psychological counselling session to assess how students were coping with the stress of ONLINE teaching. the other members welcomed the proposal.
- 4. Dr. Subhojit Ghosh requested the IQAC to organize a webinar/awareness program on Intellectual Property Rights, as NAAC had been laying a lot of stress on it in trecent times.
- 5. Dr. Sarbani Bhattacharya stresses that as coperation and sharing of resources was the need of the hour, the college should consider organizing a training program on ONLINE Teaching methodologies for School teachers. She mentioned that she herself had benefited a lot from the faculty dev program on ONLINE teaching organized by the college.

4. The college has successfully completed admission to Undergraduate courses in ONLINE mode.

Proposals / Discussion

- ONLINE TEACHING The coordinator informed the members that the college had availed the services of an ERP platform on a trial basis from an entity called campus technology. IQAC has obtained detailed faculty-wise lesson plan from different departments and the same has been uploaded on the platform. Accordingly faculties are uploading materials ,class links which students can access through their own login.
- 2. RUSA As only the vendors for desktop and antivirus software have expressed willingness to supply at quoted rates ,the college has decided to go ahead and order a larger number of desktop items than initially planned , anticipating a different teaching paradigm post-lockdown..
- 3. Dr. Sarbani Bhattacharya informed the members that WBSU will be conducting the SEM II/IV examination from DEC 15 2020 in ONLINE mode. She briefly discussed the modalities. Prof. Joydeb Biswas suggested that departmental e-mail Id could be created in the college domain and students be asked to submit answer scripts on that e-mail . Question papers to be uploaded on website ..Student data could be collected using google forms. The other members welcomed the proposal
- 4. Pricipal, Dr.Bhowmik informed members that college was planning to start admission to PG courses in ONLINE mode from November. In this context Dr. Subhojit Ghosh requested that the college consider a revised fee structure, setting aside laboratory and some other charges in view of the pandemic situation. Principal sir informed the members that it would could be considered during notification of admission.

- 5. Dr. Ghosal informed the members that in view of the shift of NAAC to a data based approach, the college needs to actively consider an ERP based solution covering

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Proceedings of the IQAC meeting held on 2.02.2021. in the ONLINE mode

The Principal began the meeting by welcoming the members of the IQAC . He also mentioned that the meeting was being held in ONLINE mode as the Lockdown in Educational Institutions was still in effect. The convenor was asked to give a brief summary of the developments which have taken place in the college since the last meeting .

Work done

- 1. Purchase of Library books almost complete from RUSA fund completed.
- 2. Renovation of Library ,bathroom along with construction of toilet for physically challenged persons in both main and VTG building.
- 3. ICT equipments under RUSA fund desktop purchased. Work order for antivirus issued.
- 4. Alumni Association Registration in final phase.
- 5. New Teacher Intake- 3 Dr. Ramaprasad Mukherjee, Ajoy Tamang, Dr Atanu Nandy
- 6. Research Project sanctioned-2.

New Initiatives/Proposal

The Principal then invited members to put forward their suggestions and comments.

- Professor Ashok Banerjee opined that the IQAC be more concerned with policy framing issues while the operational issues can be handled by the college administration.
 His suggestion was that the development activities be broken up into the following heads, namely (i) Infrastructure -both soft and hard (ii) Capacity building of human resource (iii) outreach activities (iv) Accreditation issues.
- 2. As both the upcoming NAAC and annual AQAR requires a lot of data collection across various categories Prof. Joydeb Das Biswas suggested that a criterion based committee comprising teachers of the college be formed to streamline the data collection from teachers and office.
- 3. The Principal informed the members that as the existing conference was proving inadequate for large meetings, a conference room will be set up on top floor of main building.
- 4. On enquiry by Dr. Ghosal about the proposal of initiating the value-added courses for students, Swami Kamalashthananda assured the IQAC that value-education course will be started as soon as offline classes start.



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- 5. While discussing on placement issues ,Prof.Banerjee mentioned that even in tier 1 ,tier 2 cities there are skill-based jobs which needs to be accessed -people involve in that ecosystem can be tapped for providing required skill-set to students to enable students to utilize such employment opportunities and Prof.Banerjee offered to help the college get in touch with such people. Activation of alumni network in this context was also stressed upon.
- 6. Dr. Chaitali Bhattacharya raised the issue of classes for environment Science. As itinvolved a large number of students across all departments ,accommodation in a single class was not possible. Dr. Joydeb Das Biswas suggested that the college open a youtube Channel and lectures be uploaded on it. Members welcomed the proposal and asked the IQAC coordinator to take necessary steps in this regard.
- 7. In response to the coordinator's invitation for suggestions with regard to innovations in the teaching-learning process prof. Banerjee provided two suggestions –(a) "Brown-bag " sessions where there is a sharing of teaching tools and techniques amongst the faculty members; (b) Flipped mode where students are given course materials/video lectures which students prepare as a course pre-requisite. Dr.Subhojit Ghosh suggested that for effective implementation of this participative mode the students may be asked to give presentations based on those materials.
 - Principal, Dr.Bhowmik endorsed the suggestion and asked to teacher members to hold a wider discussion on this issue ,perhaps at a teacher's council meeting.
- 8. Dr. Ghosal brought to the attention of members that tenure of the present co-ordinator has crossed two years. NAAC advises a tenure of two years , the college should initiate process of new IQAC formation.
